III. Financial Presentation	<ul> <li>3.1 Financial Update</li> <li>FY2020-21 Financial Update: Forecast Update – October – Updated with \$33K in additional expenses. Expense increase in tech services (Zoom, Wifi) and legal fees.</li> <li>2020-21 First Interim Financial Report: Current forecast &amp; actuals through October submitted on Nov. 23. Originally submitted operating budget in June.</li> <li>2020-21 Monthly Cash Balance: October 2020 cash balance was \$4.446,705.</li> <li>CARES Funding Update: School intends to spend remainder of CRF Funding by 12/30 deadline. Corona relief funds allows \$440thousand to spend by Dec. 30. As of October spent \$180,000. GEER funds have a few months after fiscal year ends. Governor's Fund end at the end of fiscal year in June. ESSER funds are able to rollover 2020- 2022 school year. Expensed already on Stipends &amp; additional hours, PD's and workshops, materials and supplies.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>State Budget Update: State Outlook – Tax receipts through October beating projections by 22.5%. State collected more tax revenue than expected. State on track to end year \$26B better than budget when budget passed June / July.</li> <li>2021: Cautiously Optimistic 20-21 Legislature could cancel all/part of Spring deferrals. Cash balance deferrals might be removed and get revenue on time.</li> <li>21-22 1.14% COLA – One time funding and pension costs paid down. Possibility of more funding for schools. Pensions might receive support from state for CALPERS/STRS participants.</li> <li>Governor's Proposal forthcoming in January. CCCS is in no need to finance as we have a health cash flow.</li> </ul>
