Dear Parent of _____,

Please be reminded that during the orientation you were informed that your child would have to attend BBP. BBP is our free after school homework help program. This program is federally funded; therefore we MUST adhere to certain guidelines.

Because your child is either a 6th grader, new to our school, or with a borderline GPA he/she MUST attend BBP from 3:30-5:45 during the month of September.

We are extremely concerned about students academic progress with so many of our parents not following the pick up time guidelines. Because of this, we could very well loose the grant and have to close school at 3:15 everyday.

Beginning Monday, September 17th, this is our new policy:

1. Students who are required to attend BPP MUST stay daily until 5:45.
2. Every family has **3 FREE early pick ups** this semester (semester ends February 4). This means you can check out early for 3 days for any reason.
3. If you **CHOSE** to sign your child out early, **the fourth (4th) early check out becomes DAYCARE** and like surrounding districts, we will charge you \$10 an hour.
4. Beginning October 1st if your child's **isn't required, but chooses to attend BBP he/she MUST attend at least 3 days a week. If not, the following consequences apply.**
5. If your child receives **In Danger of Failing Notices** on **September 21st they are required to attend BBP beginning October 21st.**
6. To be clear, **after 3 early release days the following will occur:**
