6. To CALL the school by 10:00 on the day your child is going to be absent. **You may leave a message at night up until 10:00 a.m. at 310 412-2286 extension 2.**

Failure to call the office by 10:00 will result in TRANCY!

7. To provide transportation to and from school for my child. **If I am REPEATEDLY late picking up my child I understand I may be asked to move** schools for the benefit of my child's education, he/she will be required to attend a school that is more accessible for my child. Students should NEVER stand in front of school for more than 15 minutes. _____initials

8. If my child is continually tardy, I understand that for the benefit of my child's education, he/she will be required to attend a school that is more accessible for my child. **(3 tardies and/or absences in a semester is permissible, more is excessive).** _____initials

 - ☆ **to provide weekly child-appropriate access to the Internet.**
15. If my child's grade point average (GPA) drops below a **2.7** they are on **Academic Probation** and I agree to strictly adhere to the Academic Probation requirements which include **mandatory after school tutoring and Saturday School.** _____^{initials}
